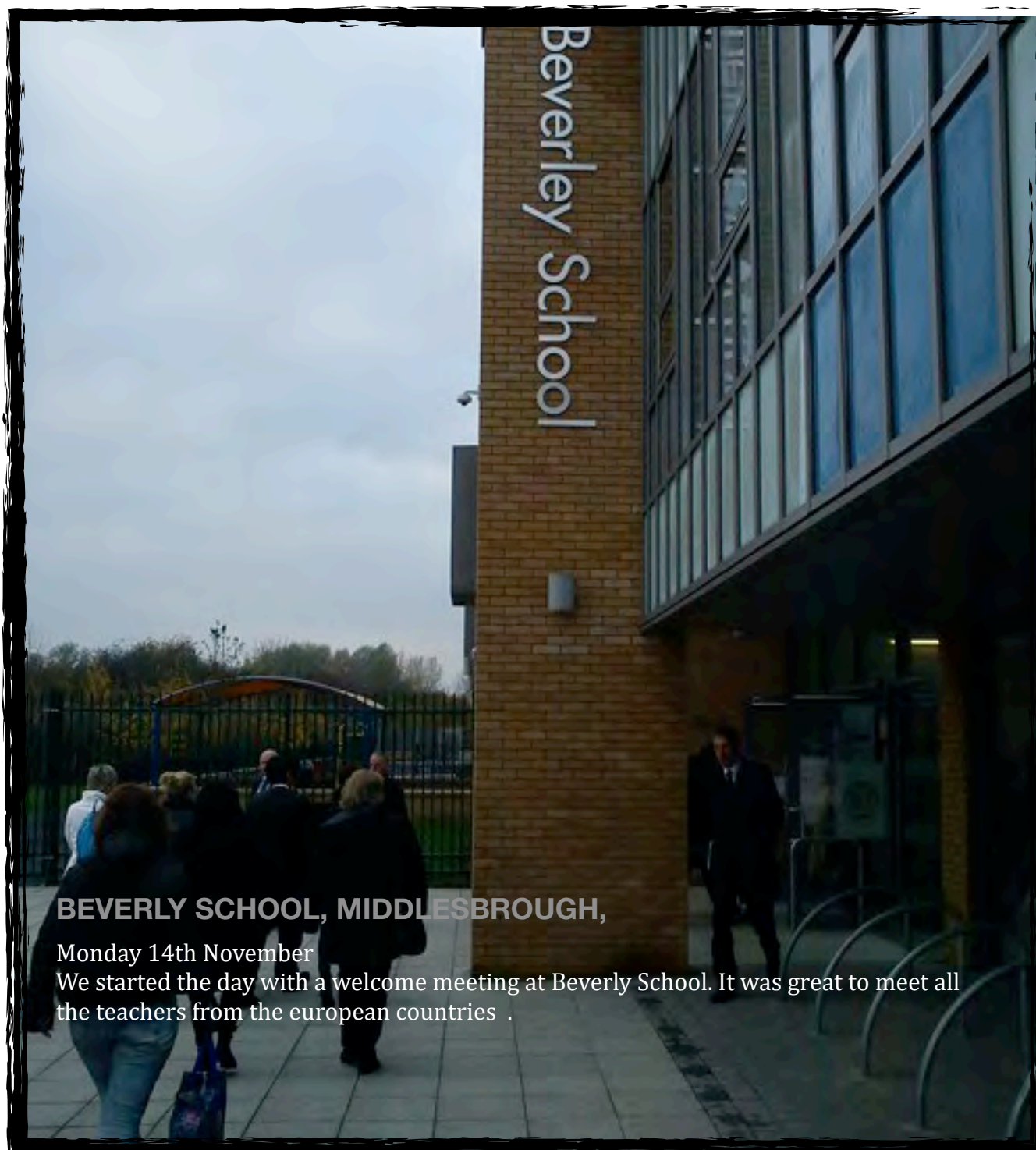


## COMENIUS / ECO-FRIENDS / UK VISIT NOVEMBER 2011



### **BEVERLY SCHOOL, MIDDLESBROUGH,**

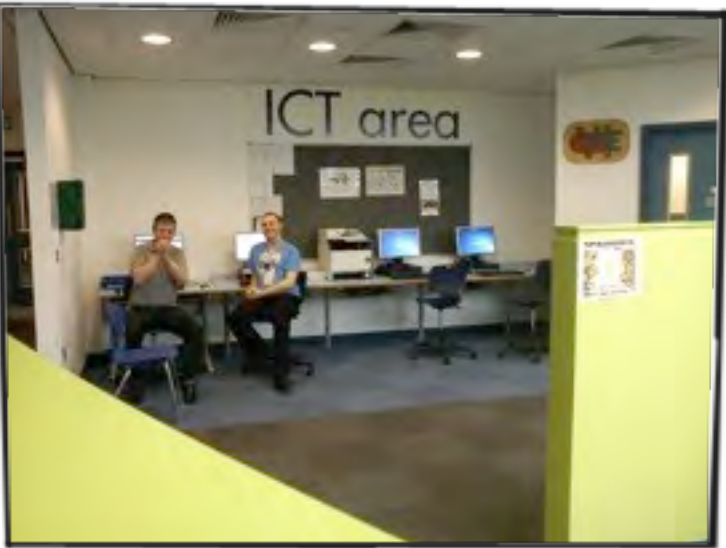
Monday 14th November

We started the day with a welcome meeting at Beverley School. It was great to meet all the teachers from the european countries .

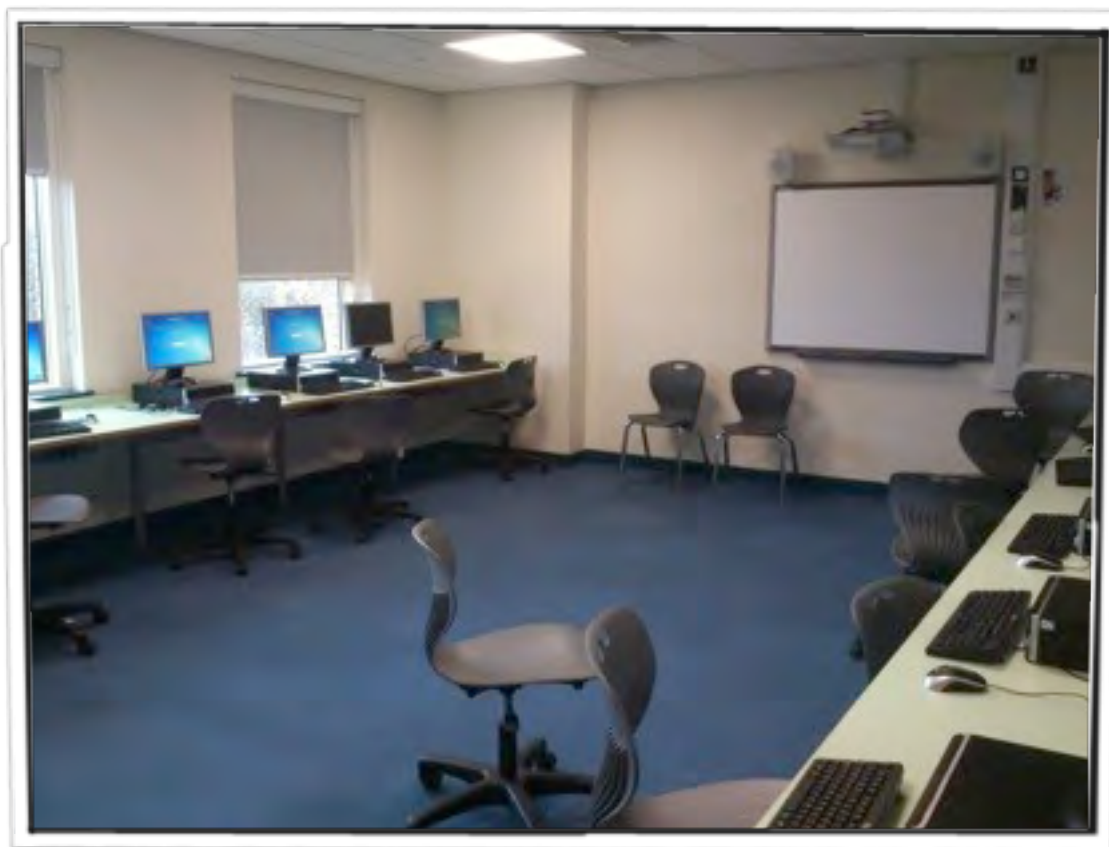




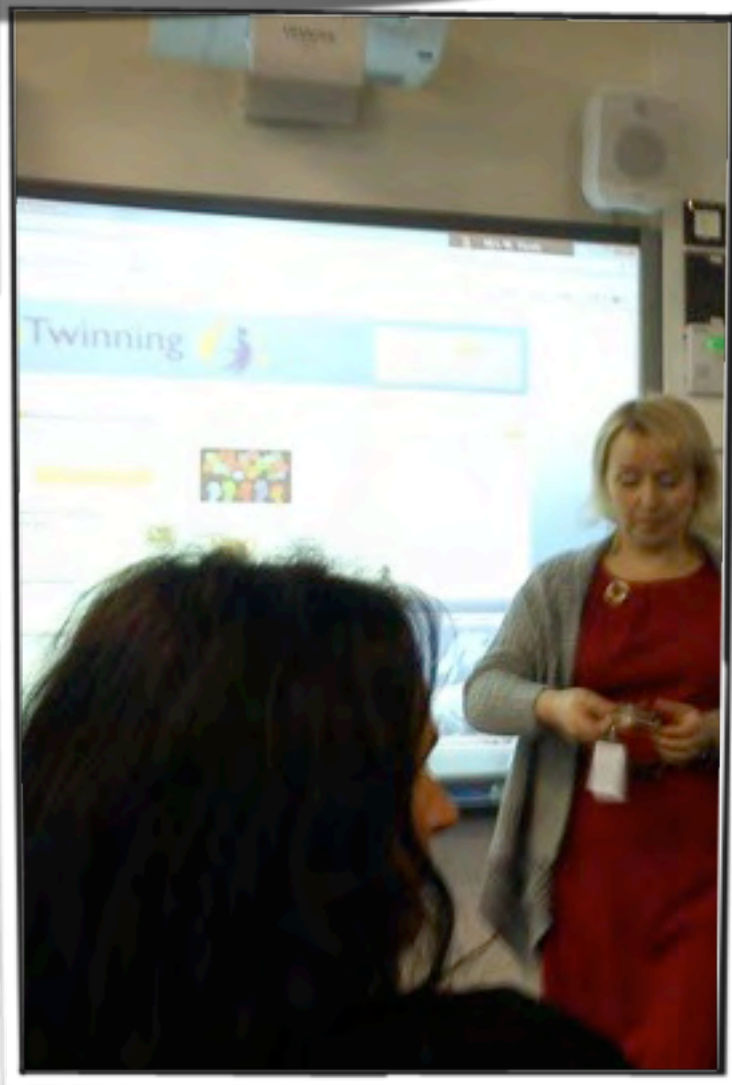
*Beverly School is a brand new school with many interesting solutions. We went for a educational tour around school*

participate in various workshops





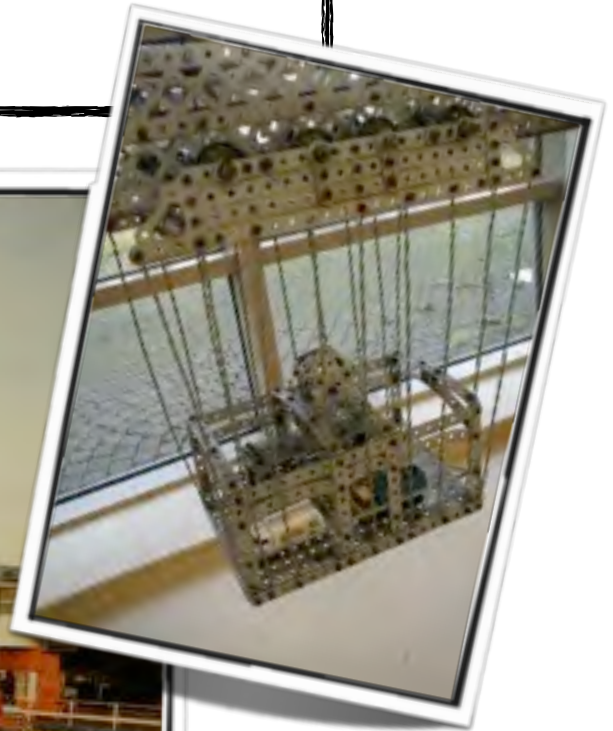
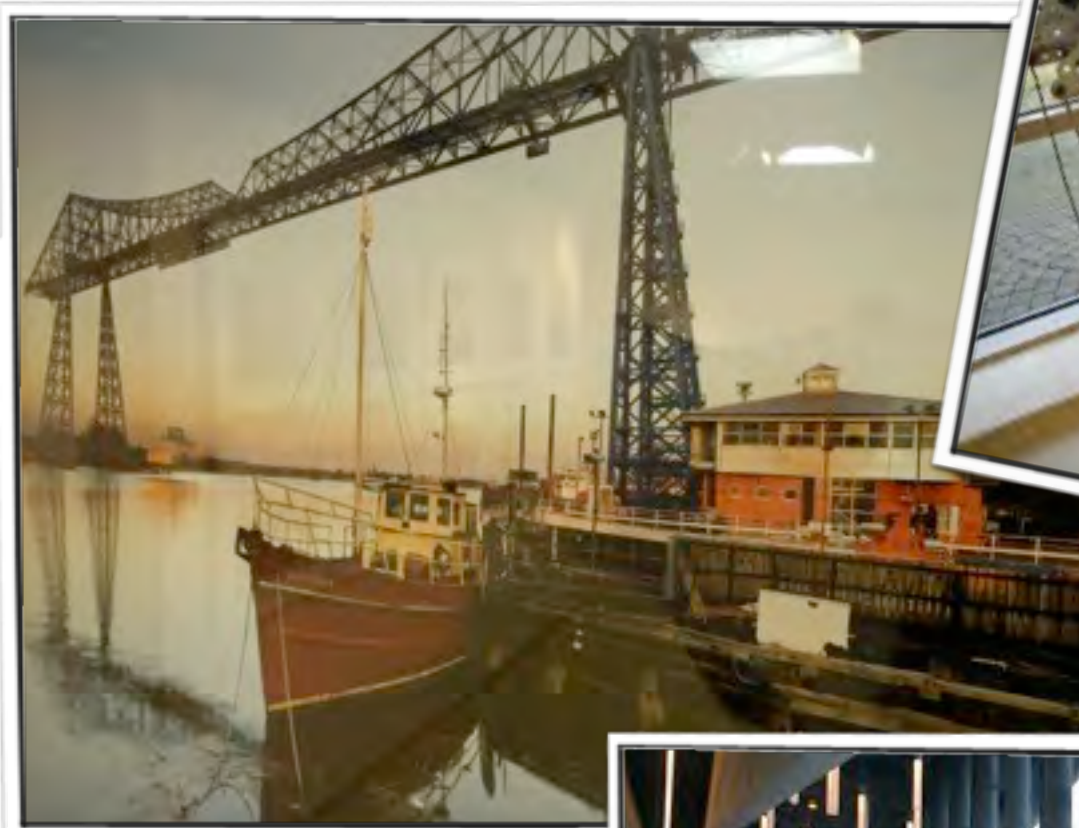
*In the evening we visit the locale seaside town Whitby. A beautiful little town in the evening light. The small streets with shops close to the sea was an great experience.*

The day started with a tour of the town planned and delivered by students at Beverly School.

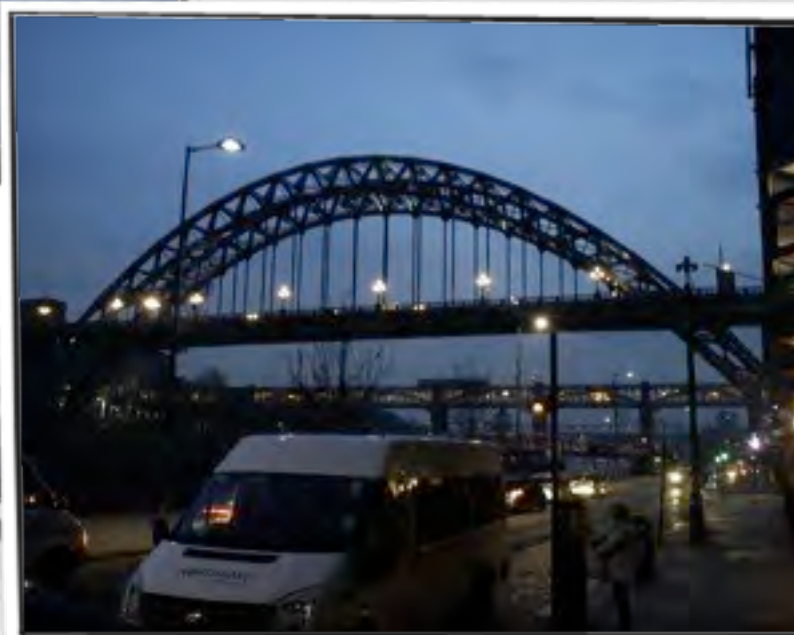
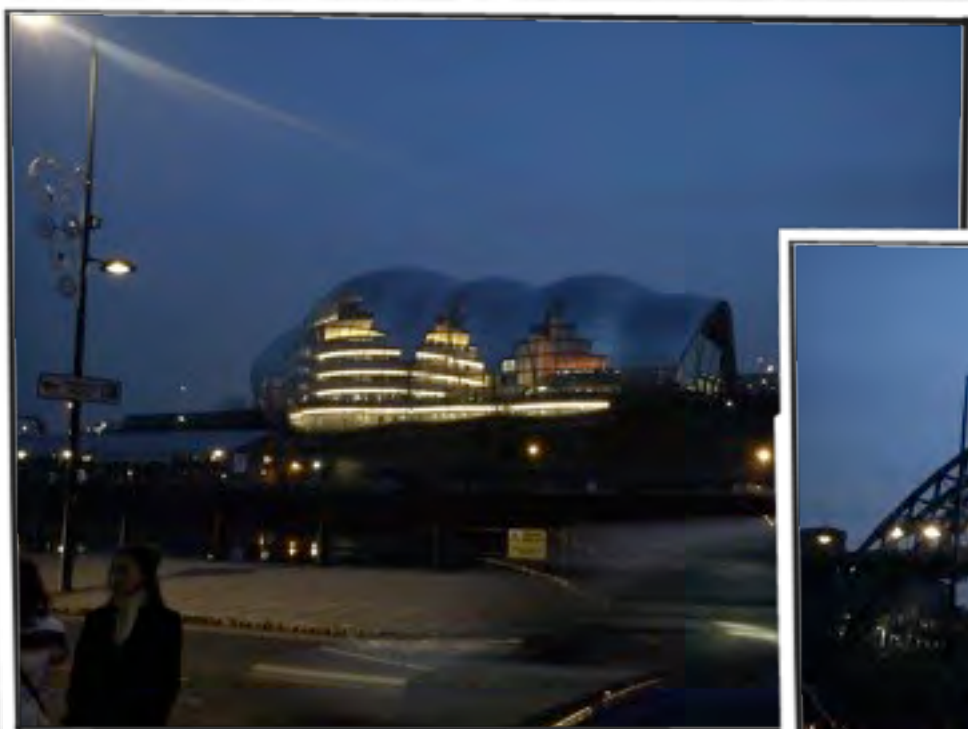






*Lunch at Café VI*

*The Lumiere festival was a light show in Durham and we were very lucky that we had the opportunity to watch all the beautiful light installations.*

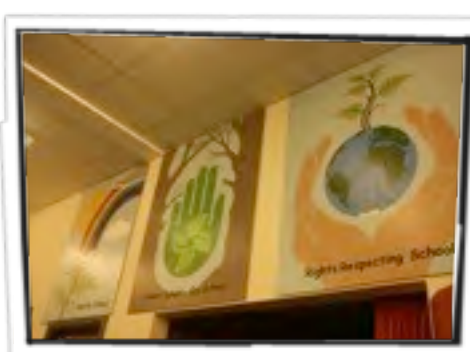






*Friday 18th November*
